It brings together youth, parents, educators, activists, and mentors from across Wisconsin and the surrounding area to learn about individual and community healing, anti-violence work centering those most impacted, and imagining violence-free futures. With keynotes Alora Young, Kay Ulanday Barret, and Aisha Fukushima the 2023 Teen Summit theme is 'rEVOLutionary ACTS' and will take place in-person!

Who Should Attend? | The event will host 700 people with the shared goal of preventing violence. Adult mentors and advocates who work with or support teens are encouraged to attend; this includes parents, caregivers, teachers and school personnel, and those involved with sexual assault and domestic violence programs, tribal programs, runaway programs, and youth-serving organizations.

Safety Note | End Abuse will monitor COVID-19 risk and make changes as needed. Attendees will be required to wear KN95 masks (provided on site) along with proof of vaccination status and/or a negative COVID-19 test result taken within 72 hours of the event. We will be providing free rapid COVID tests on-site for any attendees unable to source COVID testing outside of the event.
